LEARNING EXPERIENCE (SLE)

A core component of the MBSC Executive MBA program incorporates the Signature Learning Experience (SLE). Comprised of a set of experiential courses that specifically develop your entrepreneurial leadership, these courses require students to start their own business, scale it up, or pursue an entrepreneurial opportunity within an existing business. Students learn entrepreneurship through entrepreneurial hands-on experiences. SLE courses are supported in a number of ways, for instance through a network of mentors or the MBSC Venture Centre. Each year, several of our students are finalists and award winners in national and international competitions.

SLE is a set of experientially-based courses that support students in developing and growing entrepreneurially and to reflect on their business initiative as well as their individual and team leadership skills. SLE integrates the various discipline-based, functional components of the Executive MBA program; applies them to an entrepreneurial venture; and functions as an incubator for Entrepreneurial Thought & Action® leading to the creation of social, environmental, and economically viable business solutions for the Kingdom of Saudi Arabia and the world. Students undertake the Ideate Design Engage (LEAP) IDEeL® SLE together, to foster and strengthen collaboration and networking while working intensely to establish and grow a startup, scaleup, or corporate entrepreneurship venture.

All students begin their SLE journey together on the IDEATE SLE course and, upon completion, apply for their preferred pathway.

The SLE program consists of faculty-led teaching sessions, as well as sessions with distinguished guest speakers and seasoned mentors. However, the majority of sessions will be experiential, with students working practically on their entrepreneurial start-up, scale-up, or corporate entrepreneurship venture in small groups.

The MBSC IDEeL® SLE contributes up to 10 credits to the EMBA course, and comprises four consecutive stages across three pathways as follows:

Healthcare and Wellbeing Leadership concentration:

Health sector transformation is one of the critical components in support of realizing Vision 2030. The Ministry of Health's Vision Realization Office is working on the sector's transformation to value-based healthcare services that focus on the prevention and promotion of healthy lifestyles and well-being Kingdom wide. The most recent initiative was launched in 2022, after quality and efficiency were the focus of the initial transformation efforts, in the context of including strategy, accounting, change management, and introducing a well-being mindset to the sector.

With MBSC's world-class education delivered here in the Kingdom, there is an ideal opportunity to develop healthcare and well-being leaders ready to propel the Saudi Healthcare sector toward Vision 2030 and beyond. 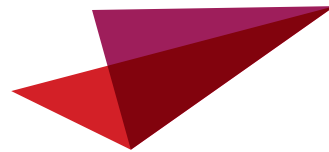
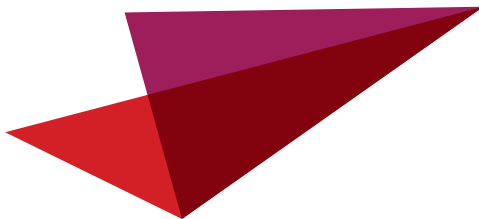
Entrepreneurial Thought, Action, and Critical Thinking
